**HD SCREENING OF
*BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN & THE E STREET BAND:
LIVE IN BARCELONA*
TO BENEFIT SYMPHONY SPACE MARCH 7**

Symphony Space and **Emerging Pictures** present a high definition digital surround sound screening of *Bruce Springsteen & The E Street Band: Live in Barcelona* on **Friday, March 7 at 8:00 P.M (\$10/Members \$8)**. This is a rare chance for New York audiences to experience this historic concert on the big screen with crystal clear picture and sound.

Throughout the `70s and `80s, Bruce Springsteen & The E Street Band barnstormed America, rocking audiences in clubs and performing arts centers. Many were, in fact, classic theaters from the Golden Age of vaudeville and “picture shows.” Bruce’s fondness for these iconic movie palaces has led to his commitment to support fundraisers to help community-based theaters underwrite ongoing digital cinema programs.

Springsteen and Emerging are providing the screening of the concert. All proceeds will go to benefit Symphony Space.

This concert—recorded live at the Palau Sant Jordi in Barcelona, Spain on October 16, 2002—features classic Springsteen tunes as well as songs from his previous album, *The Rising*.

This season Symphony Space celebrates 30 years of presenting an outstanding array of performing arts to New Yorkers. When Symphony Space opened its doors in 1978 with its first production, *Wall To Wall Bach*, it gathered together an eclectic group of musicians, professional and amateur, well-known and emerging. What began as a natural outgrowth of the cultural epicenter that is the Upper West Side, traditionally home to many of the great actors, writers, dancers and musicians of our time, remains a unique melding of world-class artistry with the informality and intimacy of a neighborhood salon.
